ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in Muamalat and recognised Islamic Finance or equivalent obtaining at least CGPA 2.50 out of 4.00; or
- Candidates with CGPA of below 2.5 but above 2.0, with a Bachelor degree from other fields, may be considered subject to additional internal assessments; or
- Admission via Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APELA):
 - At least 30 years of age in the year of application;
 - Posses at least an STPM/Diploma/equivalent application ** (or those with higher qualifications, e.g. Advance diploma, Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma);
 - Posses relevant work experience;
 - Pass the APELA assessment for Master's level

and,

- English proficiency:
 - Malaysian University English Test (MUET): Band 4 and above; or
 - IELTS – band 6; or
 - TOEFL: 9.5 (Essential), 79 (iBT) and above
- Exemption:
 - Candidates from native English speaking countries
 - Candidates with academic qualifications from institutions using English as the full medium of instruction
